Research additionally shows that children learn best by doing. In fact, studies have found that students retain up to 75% of what they actively practice, compared to far less when only reading or listening. Hands-on learning engages multiple senses, builds stronger brain connections, and leads to higher achievement in core subjects like science and math. By giving kids opportunities to dig, build, experiment, and create, Discovery Gateway Children's Museum provides the kind of learning that is both memorable and transformative—something most classrooms can't offer every day.

- **Art Studio** Encourages self-expression and creativity, which research shows is essential for innovation and overall academic achievement.
